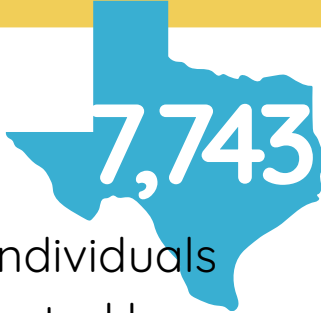

My first year as CEO, I inherited 43 years of love stitched into this community — and I learned what it means to carry that thread with my own hands.

We told the world who we really are. We became ABC of Southwest Texas, a lifeline for kids ages 0 to 17 across 17 counties. We evolved our Autism Support Program into the Autism & All Disabilities Support Program, because the families walking through our doors face up to 900 different diagnoses, and every one of those kids deserves a program built for them.

And when the world got hard, we didn't flinch. When the SNAP benefits crisis hit, we launched crisis funding. We paid light bills. We kept homes warm. That's not a program. That's a promise.

This was also the year San Antonio noticed. 10 news segments. Two podcasts. Two radio stations. Two magazines. The San Antonio Business Journal named us Best Place to Work — because you cannot pour into broken systems without pouring into people first.

For 44 years we have refused to accept the verdict handed to kids who were told they'd never speak, never walk, never connect. We didn't just provide services this year. We rewrote trajectories. We took kids who'd been handed a ceiling and gave them a sky.

To my staff, the donors, our partners, and every family who trusted us with their child's story this year — thank you. We are not just an organization. We are the thread. And we are just getting started.
